Recommendations	Action taken and outcomes
Review of Feedback Mechanism	The mechanisms used for collecting and analysing student feedback were reviewed and student feedback Performa was revised.
Strengthening Student Support Services	Various seminars, sessions and expert talks were organised on developing Life skills, Stress Management, Android Application Development, Web Development, and Digital Marketing. Orientation Programme for TCS NQT Training was also conducted.
Annual Sports Meet	a) The Annual Sports Meet - Spark 22 was successfully planned and executed to promote physical fitness, teamwork, and sportsmanship among students. b) A Sports Committee was formed, comprising faculty coordinators, physical education staff, and student volunteers, to manage the event logistics and scheduling.
Increase in intake in BCA program from session 2022-23	The management has been informed who has accepted the proposal. In the IKGPTU University affiliation process, increase in intake form 90 to 120 has been proposed for the session 2022-23.
To resume and continue admissions for the BTTM program	The management, Admission Committee and concerned department has been informed.
